

Information for all groups and individuals using Christ Church Moreton Hall

February 2022

We really appreciate all you have done to help keep your groups and our church members safe over the past months – thank you.

Now that Covid restrictions are largely lifted, we no longer have any requirements in place for groups using the building (e.g. with regard to face coverings or reduced numbers). However, government guidelines state that all indoor activities should still carry out their own risk assessments, to ensure they are minimising risks as much as possible. You may therefore want to give consideration to things like ventilation, spacing, hand sanitisers etc.

Our church cleaners visit weekly to give the church a more thorough clean. We are still asking the church stewards to give key touchpoints a quick clean before and after church services, and it would be appreciated if you might continue to do likewise before and after groups. Cleaning materials are available on the shelf in the foyer, if this is helpful to you.

Toilets and the kitchen are now available for the use of all church groups. If another group is meeting in the church building at the same time, it would be helpful if you would discuss with them how best to share use of the kitchen facilities as needed.

Please remember to turn off lights and heating when you leave the building, and to close any open windows! The heaters are easy to use in the foyer and main church – you simply press a button to say how long you would like the heaters on, and then they will turn off after that period. In the small hall, you will need to do this manually, and turn the heater to OFF please, as you leave. We hope to have this heater changed to a format like the others sometime soon. If anyone is unsure where the heating controls are located, please do contact a churchwarden or Revd Ford for advice!

I will be sending out some updated information on fire safety in a few weeks' time. In the meantime, please do ensure you read the information on the fire notices around the building, and know where the fire escapes are located in case of an emergency.
